Patricia (Pat) Elizabeth Weisgerber was born in Central Point to George and Joy Simpson.

Pat spent her early years in Grants Pass and, in 1943, the family moved to Corvallis, where Pat attended Corvallis High School, and went on to two years at Oregon State University.

Pat met Ben Weisgerber in the fall of 1948, and they were married in August of 1949. She worked at U.S. Bank in Corvallis for a few years. Later she was bookkeeper for Ben's Flying A gas station, and then worked as his secretary and bookkeeper for 15 years at B&R Wrecking. They raised three girls, Jan Weisgerber of Portland, Sue Stephens of Tigard, and Diane Meyers of Corvallis.

Ben and Pat loved to travel. Kauai, Hawaii, was a favorite vacation destination they visited each year for 23 years. They traveled to Europe, visited friends in Australia and New Zealand, and traveled around the United States, Canada and Mexico in their motor home.

Ben and Pat were members of the Corvallis County Club for more than 50 years. Pat participated in the Oregon Women's Golf Association, and won several tournaments. She enjoyed playing cards (bridge and gin rummy) with friends, and also taught her children and grandchildren to play. Pat also knitted and crocheted.

She was preceded in death by her parents, of Portland; and her sister, Gerry Schoeppel of Seattle, Wash. Pat is survived by her husband, Ben Weisgerber;

and daughters Jan Weisgerber, Sue (and Gary) Stephens, and Diane (and Brad) Meyers. She had five grandchildren, Nicholas and Andrew Stephens, and Micah, Erin and Shawna Meyers.
