While living in Santa Barbara, CA he served as associate pastor of The Church of the Open Bible. Upon retirement he served as a missionary in Wewak, Papua New Guinea. When he returned to the States, he moved with his daughter's family to Corvallis, OR. He loved woodworking, gardening and reading God's word. He was preceded in death by his father Fritz Richard Jarisch, his mother Elizabeth Otto Jarisch, his wife Betty Law Jarisch, his brother Albert Louis Jarisch, his sister Lucille Jarisch Whitlock, his son Darrell Lee Jarisch and one grandson Troy Allen Hart.
