November 23, 1925 - March 28, 2015

Peggy was born on Nov. 23, 1925, in Corvallis to Fred Hubler and Grace (Grable) Hubler.

She was the youngest of three daughters. Her family owned the Northwest Chicken Hatchery on Wake Robin Lane. She graduated from Corvallis High School in 1943, and began working for Roger's Shoes and Apparel in downtown Corvallis, a job she would hold for more than 30 years.

In 1947 she married Paul DeSalle, a Marine who was stationed at the base at the Corvallis airport. They had one daughter, Susan. Their idyllic marriage lasted until Paul's death in 1998.

Peggy is survived by her daughter; grandson, Scott; and nieces and nephews in Oregon, Utah and Pennsylvania. She was preceded in death by her husband; her parents; and sisters Annette and Arlene.
