On February 21, 1950, Robert A. Wilt was born to Joe and Dorothy Wilt. For education he attended Lincoln Elementary, Corvallis High School (Class of '68), and Oregon State University. At the age of eight he started driving tractor through rows of pole beans, by 1970 his dad gave him a few acres to farm on his own which he grew pumpkins for Halloween. In 1974 he planted his first four acres of blueberries. Through the years Bob dabbled in many different crops from Christmas trees to broccoli, to corn and just about everything in between. Around 2006 he finally settled into a focus of organic berry farming which gave way to regenerative farming practices. Bob was constantly learning, much of his knowledge was self-taught, and tested through trial and error on the farm. Today the farm produces certified organic black raspberries, blueberries, and blackberries. When Bob wasn't farming you could find him fishing, specifically on the Snake River, in Hells Canyon, on his jet boats. He leaves behind Diane, wife of 49 years, Jennifer, daughter, James, son-in-law, a loyal work force, and many other extended family members. He is preceded in death by his mom, Dorothy, and dad, Joe.
