Rosemarie Lerra Hubley passed away on the morning of Jan. 11 at Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center in Corvallis.

She dedicated her life to her family's development through roles as room-parent, den mother, team-parent, neighborhood association's officer, travel-buddy, family counselor and finance director.

Rosemarie had a deep passion for helping others succeed as demonstrated by her dedication to teaching and education. She began her journey as an educator with an associate degree from Massachusetts Bay Community College in 1976, followed by a bachelor's degree from the University of Bridgeport in Connecticut, 1978, culminating in a Master in Adult Education and Work Force Training from Oregon State University in the spring of 2000. She worked as a Business Tech Lab Assistant for the Benton Center, and

after achieving her master's, became a full-time instructor at Linn-Benton Community College in 2004.

At LBCC she found her great joy in inspiring eager learners' development and achievement of new and higher expectations. In 2007, Rosemarie became the program coordinator in the LBCC Business Technology lab in Lebanon until health issues forced a scaling back.

Rosemarie's grace and style warmed and comforted us. Her fierce loyalty and compassion guarded and protected us. She will be greatly missed and forever cherished.
