



## Samuel Albert Lewis

March 29, 1921 - February 22, 2015

Samuel Albert Lewis, 93, of Corvallis died Sunday, Feb. 22, 2015.

Mr. Lewis was born March 29, 1921, in Ramah, New Mexico, to Samuel Edward and Sarah (Cluff) Lewis. He served as a weather observer in the U.S. Army Air Corps during World War II. On June 17, 1949, he married Mablelee Hobday. The couple had two children, Tom and Melinda. Mr. Lewis was employed as an electrical engineer for CH2M Hill. He enjoyed trout fishing, gardening, church activities, and collecting and polishing rocks.

Mablelee, his wife of 58 years, preceded him in death in 2007. Mr. Lewis also was preceded in death by three great-grandchildren, Darren and Ethan Lawrence and Raymond Kimlinger. He is survived by his son, Tom Lewis; daughter, Melinda Lewis Kimlinger; grandchildren Melissa, Eric, Ryan, Jonathan and Amanda; and 13 great-grandchildren.
