



Sandie Leigh Campbell

May 9, 1969 - March 29, 2015

Sandie passed away on March 29, 2015, at Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center, surrounded by her loving family, after a traumatic injury from a fall.

She was born May 9, 1969, to Gary and Elizabeth Campbell at St. Vincent Hospital in Portland. During the first 12 years of her life, her family moved around the United States, including Gresham; University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign; San Diego, California; Eliot, Maine; and finally to Corvallis.

Sandie graduated from Crescent Valley High School in 1987. One of her highlights at CV was a trip to France in 1985 with her French class. During the trip she dyed her hair blue just to shock her parents. She graduated from University of Oregon in 1992 with a marketing degree. She loved her Ducks, but her love of Steve made her a Beaver supporter, except during Civil War games.

Anyone who knew Sandie loved her humor, laughter, cooking and caring for others. She enjoyed listening to music (loudly), cooking big meals for her family and friends (but not eating them), dancing, water skiing, snowmobiling and driving in her BMW convertible as fast as she could. Sandie was a thrill seeker; whether it was tandem parachuting or paragliding, she tried it all and always enjoyed the excitement it gave her. Her dogs were the center of her

daily life: Mocha (who passed away in December), Kagen, Wizen and her little Lilly.

Central Oregon always was a special place for her and she could not wait every month to go to their house in Eagle Crest. She was well known to all the restaurants they frequented in Bend, and always discussed the food with the chefs.

Sandie is survived by her loving husband of almost 16 years, Steve Uerlings; her beautiful daughters, Megan and Kaitlin Campbell; stepson and wife, Scott and Heather Uerlings, and stepson Brad Uerlings; parents, Gary and Elizabeth (Liesel) Campbell; sister and husband, Tammy and Ben Thompson; and nephews Jacob and Tyler Thompson. She was preceded in death by her beloved grandmother, Leola Campbell.
