Sandra Kay (Sandi) Clark of Milwaukie passed away on Monday, April 6, at the age of 58, after a long battle with cancer.

She was born Jan. 7, 1957, at Good Samaritan Hospital in Corvallis. She grew up in Philomath and Newport, graduating from Newport High School in 1975. She went on to earn a bachelor's degree in teaching at Oregon College of Education in Monmouth in 1979.

Sandi spent her entire working career of 34 years at Nike. She was a business analyst and worked on projects with staff both in the United States and worldwide. Her co-workers were her extended family. They described Sandi as positive, friendly, feisty and someone who could be counted on for pairing her extensive expertise with a passion for excellence.

Sandi also enjoyed caring for her cats (numerous rescues throughout the years), beading, gardening, and a Friday night movie at the Moreland Theatre in Portland with a shared bag of buttered popcorn! She had a passion for her friends, and loved getting together for good food, conversation and margaritas.

Sandi is survived by her father, William (Bill) Clark of Lebanon; her mother, Beverly Clark Hiersche, also of Lebanon; her sisters, Linda Clark O'Hara of

McMinnville and Carol Ann Clark of Sweet Home; her lifelong friend, Donna Fuller of Milwaukie; an uncle; an aunt; and numerous cousins.
