Stella McCann, a Corvallis resident, went to be with the Lord on June 25, 2011, at the age of 86.

She was born in Klamath Falls to Earl and Daisy Webb, and was raised and educated in Grants Pass. She met Charles "Mac" McCann while he was serving in the U.S. Army and stationed at Fort White during World War II. They were married on Oct. 29, 1944, in Grants Pass. Stella and Mac moved to Portland and then to Springfield, settling in Corvallis in 1957.

Stella was a homemaker and an active member of the Evangelical Church. After raising her children, she went to work for the Oregon State University Bookstore, and retired in 1987.
