Stoddard "Scotty" Hunter Pyle, 91, of Corvallis died on Oct. 25, 2014, at home, surrounded by his family.

Scotty, born in 1923 in Walla Walla, Washington, was the only son and last surviving child of Rhea and Louise Pyle of Yakima, Washington. Scotty served in the U.S. Navy and, while stationed in Washington, D.C., met the love of his life, Jane Pierson. They returned to Washington, where Scotty received his degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Washington.

With an inventive mind and boundless curiosity, Scotty's abilities found him traveling the world as International Marketing manager of Tektronix of Beaverton; later in life, he was a partner in the Corvallis truss manufacturing company SpeedCut. He was an active member of the Kiwanis Club of Corvallis and Northwest Hills Community Church.

The legacy of his enduring love is carried on by his wife, Jane Pierson Pyle, with support from his children, Linda Pyle Choate, Randall Hunter Pyle and Kathleen Pyle Jones. Scotty's love of family, sustained by his unshakeable faith in Jesus Christ, also has guided the lives of nine grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.
