Kelsey also enjoyed traveling as well as trying and cooking new foods.

On April 17, 2010, in Corvallis, Kelsey was blessed with her beautiful son, Theo. Nothing came more naturally to Kelsey as being a mother. Once Theo was a part of the family, it was impossible to picture one without the other. Whether it was fixing a meal or taking a nap, Theo and Kelsey were always together. Theo was a huge "mama's boy," and it was rare that you could get him away from her without upsetting at least one of them.
