Tyson Lee Schreiber was born Aug. 21, 1992, to Mark and Julie Schreiber. He graduated from Alsea High School in 2010, as salutatorian. Tyson excelled in football, basketball, baseball and track. During his senior year, Tyson went to state in four track events. He won state by jumping 20 feet, 7 inches in the long jump. In addition to track, Tyson was invited and played in the eight-man football all-star and 1A all-star basketball games.

After graduation, Tyson worked for NWFF Environmental of Philomath. In August, he began working for Brass Plumbing of Albany, owned by Jon and Mary Hanson. He was working toward becoming a plumbing apprentice. Tyson's hobbies included hunting, fishing, water-skiing, wake-boarding and camping.
