Vera Mae Amick-Deneau, 79, of Corvallis died Tuesday, March 9, at Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center.

Born in 1930 in Putnam County, Mo., Vera Mae Brummitt moved with her family to Wichita, Kan., at age 7. Two years later, they moved to Ottumwa, Iowa, and then to Billings, Mont., where Vera graduated from Billings Senior High School. In 1951, Vera moved to Salem, where she met Floyd Amick, and married him Aug. 16, 1952. Floyd and Vera later moved to Corvallis, where they remained until their deaths.

Vera loved spending time with her family. Her interests included tole painting and reading. She also loved spending time in her flower garden, sewing, making crafts and embroidery. She was a lifetime member of the Church of Christ, and had attended the Oak Street Church of Christ in Albany for the past 44 years. She was also a member of the American Legion Auxiliary.

Floyd preceded her in death in March 2002. She married Bill Deneau on Dec. 20, 2008. Bill preceded her in death in May 2009.

Vera was also preceded in death by her brother Charles Brummitt. She is survived by her brother, Art Brummitt, and his wife, Sara, of Keizer; step-daughter, Caron, and her husband, Barry Johnson, of Corvallis; son, Dan, and his wife, Judi, of Billings; daughters Becky Kassab of Corvallis, Trudy Rector and her husband, Bill, of Corvallis, and Sandra Amick of Walnut Creek, Calif.; 10 grandchildren; 15 great-grandchildren; 10 great-great-grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews.
